



STELLAR RECORD IN OBTAINING AWARDS OF COSTS AND ATTORNEYS' FEES

Arnold & Porter has amassed an impressive track record in obtaining for its clients awards not only of costs, but also attorneys' fees, as in the cases listed below:

- 1. Latam Hydro LLC and CH Mamacocha S.R.L. v. Republic of Peru (ICSID Case No. ARB/19/28) (Award, December 20, 2023): the tribunal ordered the claimants to reimburse 100% of the arbitration costs and 100% of legal fees incurred by Peru.
- 2. Panamericana Television S.A. et al. v. Republic of Peru (PCA Case No. 2019-26) (Award, December 1, 2022): the ICSID tribunal ordered the claimant to reimburse 65% of the arbitration costs incurred by Peru, plus interest.
- 3. A cross-border, cross-office team of lawyers from San Francisco, Shanghai, London, and Washington DC represented a California technology company in a significant ICC arbitration (nearly USD 100 million at issue) with a Korean counterparty.
